Following the devastating Bundaberg floods in February 2013, Australian Temporary Structures | ATS was enlisted to establish emergency relief accommodation for 300 people displaced by the floodwaters.

The Australian Temporary Structures | ATS team was charged with building a 300-bed camp and mess hall with facilities to cater for up to 450 people onsite at the Bundaberg showground. Australian Temporary Structures | ATS role in this

project involved coordinating logistics, installation and onsite management in a tight timeframe, whilst achieving a comfortable environment for the displaced.
